## WHAT DOES THE BIBLE SAY?

### Matthew 20:29-34

And as they departed from Jericho, a great multitude followed him. And, behold, two blind men sitting by the way side, when they heard that Jesus passed by, cried out, saying, Have mercy on us, O Lord, thou Son of David. And the multitude rebuked them, because they should hold their peace: but they cried the more, saying, Have mercy on us, O Lord, thou Son of David. And Jesus stood still, and called them, and said, What will ye that I shall do unto you? They say unto him, Lord, that our eyes may be opened. So Jesus had compassion on them, and touched their eyes: and immediately their eyes received sight, and they followed him.

## LET'S THINK ABOUT IT!

- Have you ever asked for help? What happened?
- Have you ever tried to help someone else that needed help? How did that make you feel?
- Can you imagine how it would be to not see? How would your life be different?

# ACTIVITIES:

- Blindfold one of the children and then give them different objects to feel. See if they can guess the object!
- Talk about eyesight, ways to protect our eyes, or ways that we can see (contacts/glasses/surgery) if we have vision issues. Remind children these things were not available at the time of this story.
- Include the children in prayer by asking them if they have a special request and encourage them to ask God for help just as the blind men did.
- Sing the song "Head, Shoulders, Knees, & Toes." Be sure to point out your eyes discussing how we can use them to identify other parts of our body as well as touch!
